We shall open our service today by remaining seated and singing

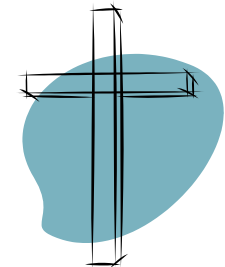
