## Castle Credit Union

**Castle Credit Union( formerly Craigmillar Credit Union) is coming to this area in September**

Castle Credit Union is opening a collection point at Gilmerton Community Centre on Monday, September 3<sup>rd</sup> 1.30 to 3.30pm. This will be staffed weekly by volunteers from SEECAT, ( SouthEast Edinburgh Churches acting together), which includes our own church.

Credit Unions are not for profit organisations and are being acknowledged as key tools in the battle to combat financial exclusion. It is a harsh reality for millions of people on limited or no income that they are unable to access even the most basic financial services of the type many of us take for granted.

A Credit Union can provide a vital financial lifeline for managing tight budgets and planning for larger expenses such as Christmas and holidays. Additionally borrowing from a credit union offers an affordable and realistic alternative to the punitive interest rates typically attached to the limited range of credit on offer to people on low incomes.

However, Credit Unions are not just for those on limited incomes. Anyone in EH 16/17 can join. If we look at the concept of self help and mutual co-operation then the more of us in the area who save will ensure the future of credit unions as well as being offered the equal benefits of regular saving.
