Presbytery of Edinburgh Superintendence Report for Liberton Northfield Church

At the Presbytery of Edinburgh on Tuesday 12th March, Liberton Northfield was one of three churches that had their superintendence report moved. This was to endorse the Aims and Objectives of the congregation and encourage us in addressing these self-set challenges. Here is a summary of the Aims and Objectives:

Worship - Explore the feasibility of having regular practice with choir and musicians to encourage and prepare for Sunday Worship times.

Evangelism - Set up new Membership Classes as Alpha, although good for many, does not suit everyone.

Service - Explore reasons for people not becoming members and seek additional leaders (including leaders for children's work and youth work) and elders.

Discipleship - Form a committee of Bible Study Leaders with regular meetings to revise study materials.

Fellowship - Identify people to take ownership of tea and coffee, and other rotas.

Wider Church - Sustain involvement in parish grouping, Big Idea events (encouraging continued congregational engagement) and involvement in SEECAT (Ecumenical grouping covering 4 Churches of Scotland with 3 Catholic Churches and 1 Episcopal Church).

Ministry Team and Leadership Roles - help people identify their gifts and talents, and nurture them to have the confidence to use them in service and leadership roles.

Property - Update heating system, review vestry facilities, review storage requirements for premises uses such as Trailblazers.

Stewardship - Promote via regular items in notices plus an annual event linked to Sunday sermons and review annually at Kirk Session.

Plan for Presbytery - Engage with Presbytery and Parish Grouping for support and review annually at Kirk Session.

Communication - Establish an expanded Communications and Publications group; review Communications and Publications group annually at Session; review and revitalise website; explore ways of getting feedback from congregation.

Other - Review prayer ministry team guidelines and training; review Prayer Meetings, Prayer Focus etc. at Kirk Session; plan one 24 hour prayer event for the Church.
