Any volunteers would have a short interview, and would need to complete a PVG disclosure which would be paid for, and would require to provide 1 reference.

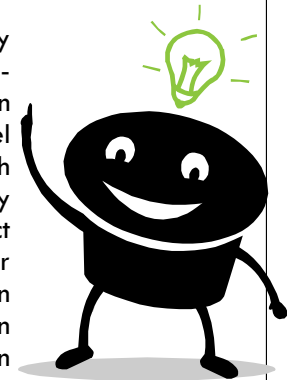
This is a great opportunity to lend a helping hand within the community and if you are interested then please speak to the minister who is Chaplain to Braeside.
