Happy New Year to all, and may you know the presence and blessing of God in 2014.

I'm glad to be with you today, the first Sunday of John's retirement, and thought it would be good to use the Newsheet just to keep you in touch with our progress in looking for his successor.

In December, both the Kirk Session and the Congregation agreed the terms of the Five-Year Reviewable Tenure, and this was approved at the December meeting of the Presbytery. A couple of nights later the Kirk Session met with the Presbytery Advisory Committee (who help us think about what kind of person we might look for) and the following Sunday the Nominating Committee was chosen by the Congregation. All this means that we are as far along in the process as we could expect to be at this time.

In early January the Advisory Committee will meet with the Nominating Committee to enlarge on the previous discussion with the Session, and then we will proceed to produce a profile of the Parish setting out our situation as it is at the moment and also our hopes for the future. Only when this has been completed will the Nominating Committee proceed to advertise for applicants and recommendations.

It is my intention that you should know as much as is appropriate within the constraints of the confidentiality of the Nominating Committee's work, and either Alistair Lawson or myself will pass on occasional updates. If you have any questions that we are allowed and able to answer, we'll be happy to do so.

Next week, our Locum, Rev Amos Chewachong will be conducting the services.
